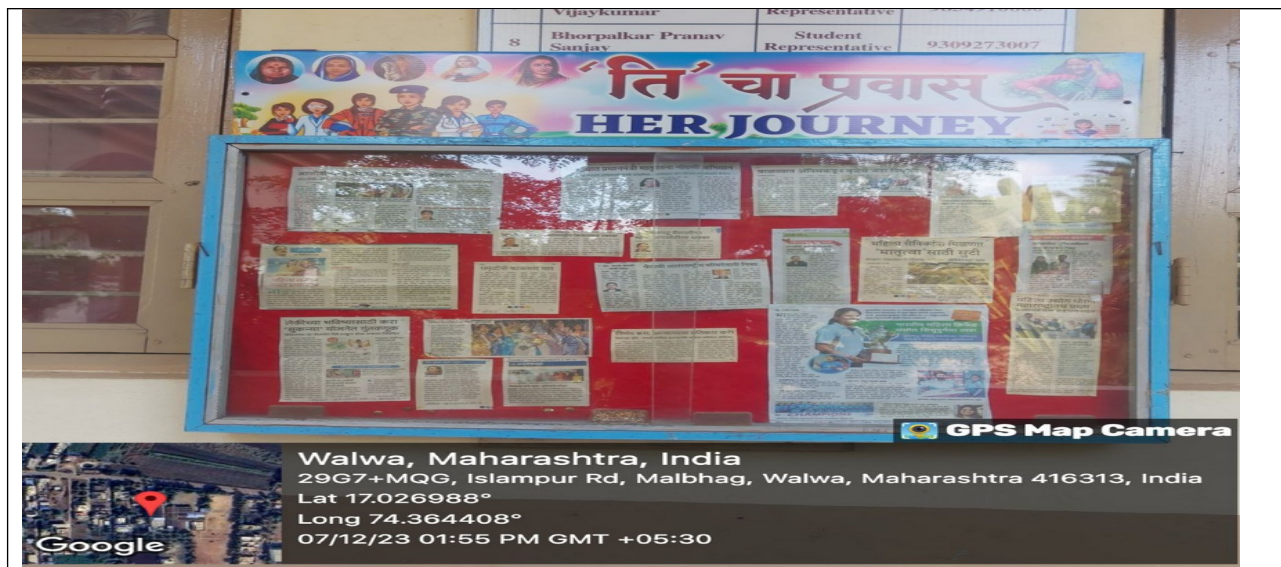
The committee chairman Miss. Sunita Kadam did this work persistently for inspiration of college Girls. This helps to motivate and encourage the girl students .

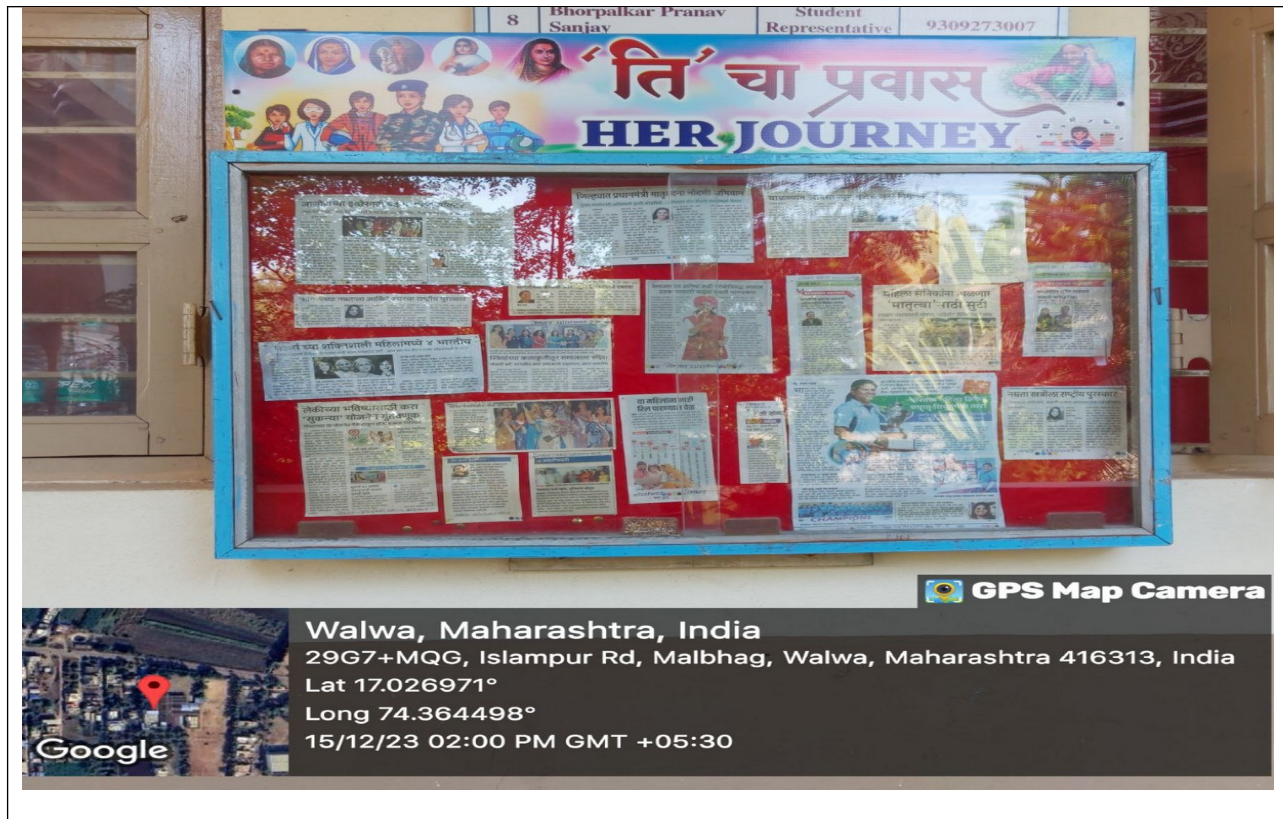
This year Committee is conducting One Week Self Defense Training Program only for College Girls during December 2023.
