The Department of English, Krantisinh Nana Patil College, Walwa organized a twelve days (30 Hours) Value Added Course on Correct English Usage In Both Speech and Writing for B.A.III English students to enhance themselves in correct written and spoken English communication in the sphere of globalization. The Course was coordinated successfully by Patil R. J. (Course-Coordinator) from 10/2/2024 to 21/2/2024.

The main objective of the Course was to train students in English conversation on the basis of standard English pronunciation .
