Everyday tech use: Social media, online payments, apps, emails.

Risks: Identity theft, scams, stalking, cyberbullying.

Women-specific risks: Online harassment, misuse of photos, blackmail.

Types of Cyber Crimes Targeting Women Cyberstalking

Online harassment (DMs, threats), Image-based abuse (morphing, revenge porn)

Phishing scams (fake messages/emails), Identity theft, Job/internship scams targeting students.

Clicking on unknown links or downloading attachments.



Meeting online strangers without telling anyone.

Trusting someone just because they seem 'nice' online.

Cyber Safety Tips :

- 🔒 Smart passwords – Use strong, unique passwords. Enable 2FA.
- 🔒 Privacy settings – Limit what you share publicly.
- 🧠 Think before you click – Don't trust unknown links or emails.
- 🖼️ Protect your images – Don't share personal photos with people you don't trust completely.

What to Do If You're a Victim:

Don't panic.,Block/report the offender.

Keep evidence (screenshots, messages),. Talk to a trusted adult or teacher.

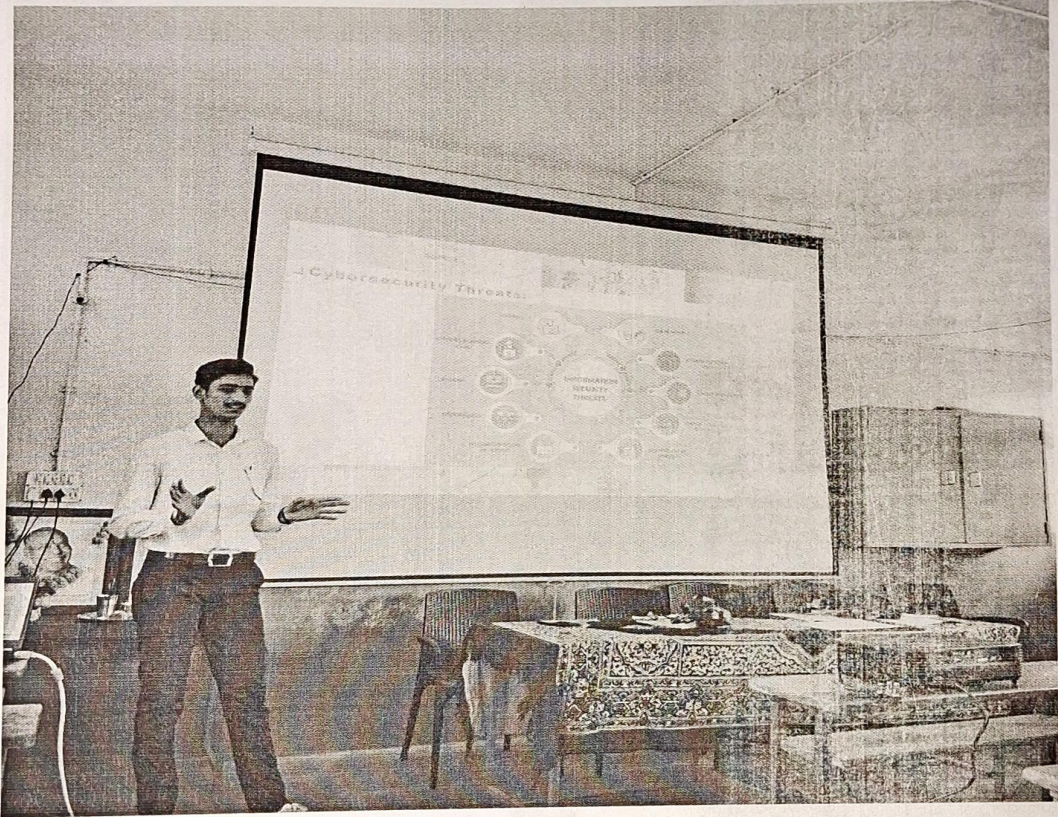
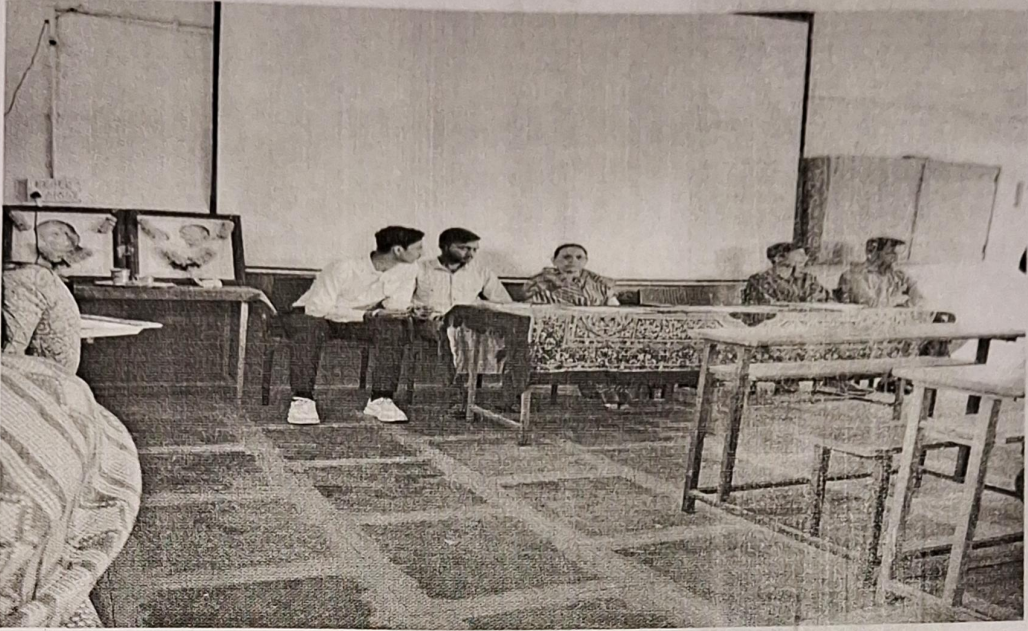

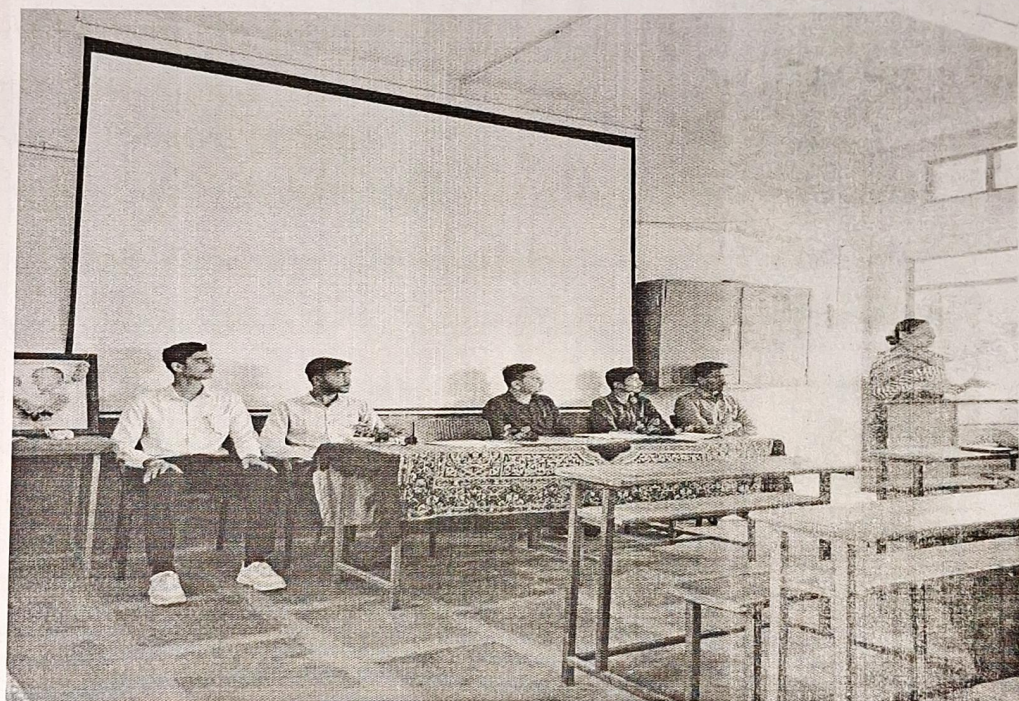
They all encourage students to ask questions, share concerns, or talk about things they've seen/heard online.
